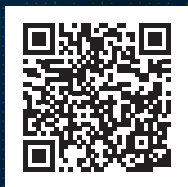

PROGRAM OVERVIEW



Through the combination of hands-on training and theory from industry professionals, students in the Pharmacy Technology

program will learn how to accurately compound and prepare sterile and non-sterile medication orders, fill outpatient prescriptions, order medications, organize inventory, enter customer information, process insurance claims and much more. In most hospitals, pharmacy technicians will mix medications as ordered by the health care provider, call physicians, long-term care facilities for prescription refill authorizations. Graduates will take the national certification exam which is recognized by the pharmaceutical industry. The program is accredited by the American Society of Health-Systems Pharmacist (ASHP).

Degree program length is sixty-five (65) credit hours.

Diploma program length is fifty-six (56) credit hours.
