

Proof of Georgia Residency - In-State Tuition

List of Acceptable Documents

- **Georgia Driver's license** - Date of issue must be at least one year ago. If the date of issue is less than one year you must obtain a MVR report from the DMV for the original date of issue.
- **Georgia Voter Registration Card** - Date of registration must be at least one year ago. If you do not have your card you can go online to <http://sos.georgia.gov/elections/polllocator/> and print out a copy.
- **Georgia Car Tag Receipt (Vehicle Registration)** - Must date back at least one year. If it does not you must obtain the current one and the one from the previous year.
- **Georgia State Tax Return (Form 500)** - Must be the most current filing year and residency status must be a 1 on line 4.
- **Employer's Statement** - The letter must state that you have been employed with the company for a year and the address on the initial application and currently on file is a Georgia address. Must be on company letterhead.
- **Copy of Parent's license / learner's license** - This only applies if you are under the age of 24 and one or both of your parents is a resident of Georgia and they claimed you on their most recent taxes and you filed as a dependent with Financial Aid.
- **Lease** - The date on the lease must be at least one year ago. If the date is less than a year you will have to get the current lease and the one immediately preceding it.
- **Military Documentation** - Military I.D. card or dependant card and orders stationing you or your spouse at Georgia. Also, this only qualifies you for in-state tuition and the HOPE grant. You will NOT qualify for the HOPE scholarship; you must be a Georgia resident to qualify for this. (The code for this is always Military - Out of State).
