

OSHA 30-HOUR SAFETY

For General Industry

The OSHA 30-Hour for General Industry course is beneficial for safety program managers and others who ensure safety of employees. This outreach training provides an overview of the hazards workers may encounter on a job site—with emphasis on hazard identification, avoidance, control and prevention, not OSHA standards.

The class is delivered over four days by an OSHA Authorized Trainer. After successfully completing the course, participants will receive a 30-hour training certificate and an official OSHA 30 wallet card.

- Electrical Safety
