



SkillBridge Accelerated Training Programs

Commercial Truck Driving (CDL)

Spring / Summer / Fall Start Dates

Prepares students for careers in commercial transportation by providing foundational training in commercial vehicle operations, safety regulations, trip planning, and defensive driving.

Graduates are prepared to test for the Georgia Class A Commercial Driver's License and enter the transportation workforce.

- Daily Schedule: Monday-Friday 8:00 – 4:00
- Location: The Puckett Center – CDL Training Site
- Length: 8 weeks
- Credential: Commercial Truck Driving TCC

Welding – Basic Shielded Metal Arc Welder

January, August Start Dates

Prepares students for entry-level welding roles by introducing welding safety, equipment setup, blueprint reading, and shielded metal arc welding techniques. Emphasis is placed on hands-on skill development aligned with industry expectations.

- Daily Schedule: 0730 – 1130 (Morning instructional block) / 1230 – 1630 (Afternoon instructional block) Students rotate through instructional and lab periods within these windows depending on course sequencing and lab availability.
- Location: Welding Lab / The Puckett Center
- Length: 10 weeks
- Credential: Basic Shielded Metal Arc Welder TCC

Welding – Gas Metal / Gas Tungsten Arc Welder (Basic Shielded Included)

January, August Start Dates

Prepares students for advanced welding roles by building proficiency in gas metal arc and gas tungsten arc welding processes. Instruction reinforces welding theory, quality control, and preparation for industry qualification testing.

- Daily Schedule: 0730 – 1130 (Instructional/Lab Block) / 1230 – 1630 (Instructional/Lab Block) / 1700 – 2000 (Advanced lab blocks on select days) Evening lab periods are used for advanced processes (GMAW/GTAW), cutting technologies, and extended hands-on practice.
- Location: Welding Lab / The Puckett Center
- Length: 15 weeks
- Credential: Gas Metal Arc Welder TCC | Gas Tungsten Arc Welder TCC



Industrial Electrician

January, August Start Dates

Prepares students for industrial electrical maintenance and installation roles by covering electrical safety, AC/DC theory, motor controls, industrial wiring, and troubleshooting. This program functions as a pre-apprenticeship pathway toward journeyman-level employment.

- Daily Schedule: Monday-Friday 9:00 – 5:00
- Location: CTC Campus
- Length: 15 weeks
- Credential: Industrial Electrician TCC

Basic Electrical Technician

January, August Start Dates

Prepares students for foundational electrical roles by developing skills in electrical theory, residential and light industrial wiring, blueprint interpretation, and basic troubleshooting.

- Daily Schedule: Monday-Friday 8:00–5:00
- Location: CTC Campus
- Length: 15 weeks
- Credential: Basic Electrical Technician TCC

Medical Coding (*Parallel Job Shadowing*)

January, August Start Dates

Prepares students for entry-level medical coding roles by developing knowledge of medical terminology, anatomy, healthcare documentation, and coding systems used to support billing and revenue cycle operations. Instruction is delivered in an online format to support flexible participation.

- Daily Schedule: Monday-Friday 7:30–3:30
- Location: Online / Job Shadowing Site
- Length: 15 weeks
- Credential: Medical Coding TCC

EMS Technician

January, August Start Dates

Prepares students for entry-level emergency medical services roles through instruction in patient assessment, emergency care, clinical skills, and operational readiness. Program includes classroom instruction and applied clinical components.

- Daily Schedule: Monday-Friday 7:30–3:30 (excludes clinical hours)
- Location: CTC Campus
- Length: 15 weeks
- Credential: EMS Technician TCC



Paralegal

January, August Start Dates

Prepares students for entry-level paralegal roles by developing skills in legal research, document preparation, case management, and professional communication to support attorneys and legal teams.

Generative AI Technician

Prepares students for emerging technology-enabled roles by introducing applied generative AI concepts, tools, and workflows used to support business operations, data analysis, and technology teams.
